



**NEW HORIZONS COUNTRY DAY SCHOOL
OLDER 2'S /YOUNG 3'S FEBRUARY MONTHLY**



FINE MOTOR: During the month of February your child will be working on fine motor skills by painting on an easel, cutting, tracing and writing their first and last names.

LANGUAGE: Language development will include memory recall with stories. The children will continue working on name recognition. We will continue to encourage the use of expanded vocabulary and review concepts of print. The colors for the month are red, white, and pink. We will be reviewing the letters T,V,D,X

MATHEMATICS: The students will be estimating, combining, separating and comparing sets. We will fine tune our math skills by comparing similarities and differences. The shapes for the month are the heart, circle and the crisscross. The numbers for this month are 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8. The students will be comparing sizes and reviewing all their shapes.

SOCIAL/SCIENCE: In keeping with Dental Health week we will have a visit from the Dentist. The Hygienist will explain the importance of brushing your teeth and what it is like to visit the Dentist. During the Month of February we will be explaining the importance of exercise and eating a healthy diet. During outside playtime our three's will be practicing jumping, walking on a line and balancing on one foot. Our three's will also be discussing transportation and traveling by Sea & Air.





SENSORY: We will be introducing the differences between rough, smooth, hard and soft.
