FINE MOTOR: During the Month of April our Pre K students will continue to work on their fine motor skills by cutting and writing their names. As we prepare for Kindergarten, the students will be reviewing all the skills they have accomplished this year.

GROSS MOTOR: We will be fine tuning our gross motor skills by walking on a line and skipping on the playground.


LANGUAGE: During our language curriculum we will continue with story comprehension. After we have read a story we will be encouraging class participation with open-ended questions to help encourage comprehension and story recall. As we get ready for Kindergarten we will continue with our Letter Recognition and reviewing our lower case letters as well as positional words.

MATHEMATICS: As part of our Math experience we will be comparing lengths, heights, shortest to longest, ordering by lengths, ordering by events, size and patterns. We will be combining, separating and working on equal groups. The students will also be working with money.

SOCIAL/SCIENCE: In Science we will be learning about plants and how they grow. In keeping with our Earth Day Celebration we will be studying about our environment and how we can be green friendly. During Zoo week the students will be introduced to different zoo animals. Along with spring comes the bugs, we will be studying different kind of insects in our environment. The week of 4/11 the students will be studying about the different dinosaurs that used to live on our planet earth.

Children's Friendships



Studies have found that some friendships formed in the early years of childhood are second only to family relationships in importance. From such findings comes a heightened awareness of the social and emotional significance of friendships when children are young. Enrollment in a preschool program offers children social experiences that might not be available to them in relationships with adults or siblings.

Interaction with and acceptance by peers have long-term effects on a child's life. Preschoolers develop social competence in three main areas: initiating interactions, maintaining ongoing relationships, and solving conflicts with other children.

Early childhood educators value the mastery of skills that lead to social competence. We encourage your children to express opinions and ideas, as well as to respect others, offering them many opportunities to negotiate and compromise within the structure of our program.



MEDICATION NOTICE

New Horizons is prohibited from dispensing any non-prescription medication of any kind (this includes over the counter drugs such as Aspirin, Tylenol, cough medicine, vitamins, lotions, etc.) If your doctor recommends an over the counter medication for your child we must have a prescription from your child's doctor.

In order for our staff to dispense any prescription medication, a parent must sign a New Horizon's consent form. The medication consent forms are available from your child's teacher. All medication must remain in the original container showing a pharmacist's label that indicates the child's name, type and date of prescribed medication, amount and times of dosage. You may wish to check with your physician regarding long-term dosage for your child's prescription so that you will be solely responsible for administering your child's medication in the morning and evening.

Do not put medication in your child's lunch box! It must be given to a staff member to be placed in a lock-box out of the children's reach.
