- Fees are structured to include tuition, arts, crafts, 2 daily snacks, supplies, one NH T-shirt and a camp bag. (There may be additional charges for some field trips). Please see the registration form if you wish to purchase additional t-shirts.
- 3. There is NO REFUND of registration fees or camp tuition for unused days or sessions.
- 4. There is a \$35 fee for returned checks.
- 5. There is a \$20 late fee for tuition received after 4pm Monday.
- 6. Changes to Field Trips: Field trips may be changed due to weather, scheduling conflicts with trip providers, illness, transportation problems or other factors beyond our control.
- 7. LUNCH: parents are responsible for providing a nutritious lunch with two water bottles.
- 8. Field Trip Departure: Departure will be posted on your weekly calendar. All students are required to be at school no later than 9:00 am . If your child is not present at the time of departure, the camp considers them absent for the day. We cannot make accommodations for students who miss the bus.
 - All field trips begin and end at New Horizons Country Day School.
- 9. NH t-shirts must be worn on FIELD TRIPS. If your child is not wearing his/her t-shirt and additional t-shirt will be issued and a fee of \$12.00 will be billed to your account.
- 10. DRESS CODE: Campers are expected to dress appropriately
 - A. Campers are to wear closed toed shoes (ex: sneakers) No crocs or flip flops or opened back shoes or boots
 - B. No spaghetti straps or mid-drifts tops
 - C. Skirts and shorts should be mid thigh
 - D. Clothing should not have printing or graphics that is inappropriate.
 - E. Younger campers and those prone to bathroom accidents are encouraged to bring a change of clothes with them to camp.
 - F. Swimming days: Campers need to wear their bathing suit under their NH t-shirt and wear Shorts over their bathing suit. Please wear closed toed shoes. Students will be going to the park after swimming— please make sure they have a complete set of clothing including under garments. Please send in a towel with your child's name on it.
 - G. Campers should have a hat.
 - H. Please label all clothing including hats, towels, lunch boxes
- 11. New Horizons will not be responsible for lost, misplaced or stolen monies or other personal property.
- 12. No cell phones
- 13. Movie Policy: All students will be viewing G and PG movies as part of our program.

SUMMER CAMP DISCIPLINE POLICY



New Horizons views discipline as a means of helping children become more socialized as they gain self-control and accept the rules of social learning and living. We provide children with many opportunities to practice expected behavior, a skill that is mastered gradually and with age.

New Horizons encourage the following good character traits: honesty, integrity, fairness, perseverance, citizenship, respect, responsibility, self-discipline, trustworthiness and caring.

Student Code of Conduct:

- 1. Students are expected to stay with camp staff in assigned activity areas.
- 2. Students will show courtesy, respect and good manners towards fellow students and staff.
- 3. Students will use appropriate language and gestures.
- 4. Students will keep hands and feet to themselves. No kicking, hitting or inappropriate touch. No fighting.
- 5. Students will be respectful of property belonging to center and students. Parent/Guardian will be responsible for payment of any damaged or destroyed property.
- 6. Good sportsmanship.
- 7. No toys are to be brought from home.
- 8. Student will abide by all bus/van safety rules.

When a staff member's intervention is necessary to maintain safety and guard the rights of others, inappropriate behavior will be handled according with each individual by the following steps:

- **1. Redirection** of disruptive and/or inappropriate behaviors to acceptable behavior(s) with a **verbal warning**.
- 2. **Student consequences** to include loss of free time, recess, participation suspended from activity for one or more days.
- Written discipline form sent home with parent signature needed to return to school. If a student is unable to gain self control of their actions and/or emotions, parents will be called and expected to immediately pick up their child
- 4. Privileges suspended as a consequence of disruptive behavior. Parent/ Administrative conference required to re-enter school. This step will be an immediate result of unsafe behavior while on a camp trip and/or riding in the school vehicle as well as physical actions toward a staff member and/or fellow schoolmates.
- 5. Dismissal from the school. Immediate dismissal will occur if a child leaves the premises by themselves, physically hits/harms a staff member, purposely harms another child by lashing out in anger or loss of emotional control. Parent(s) will be held responsible for any fees from date of dismissal as well as any outstanding balance.
